The Montana Memory Project is a collection of digital collections and items relating to Montana's cultural heritage. In part, these collections and items document the Montana experience. Many of the items are digitized copies of historic material, some items are contemporary. Content may include maps, copies of photographs, rare books, historic documents, diaries, oral histories, audio and video clips, paintings, illustrations and art.

The Montana Memory Project provides access to high quality, digital objects of physical and born-digital items collected or created by its contributing members. Collections that are unique, sustainable, that tell a story and that interrelate to other collections are encouraged in the Montana Memory Project. All content serves as a resource for education, business, pleasure, and lifelong learning.
